Vincent, a teenage humpback whale, is the orphaned son of the last Whale Singer, whose magical song once protected the oceans. Haunted by the loss of his parents, Vincent doubts his own abilities. When the monstrous Leviathan escapes from a melting iceberg, threatening all marine life with its deadly ink, Vincent must find his own song to stop the threat. But overwhelmed by self-doubt, he instead embarks on a perilous journey into the deep sea to bring his parents back from the mythical Star Pool, hoping his father can defeat the Leviathan in his place. Joined by Walter, his devoted cleaner fish nanny, and Darya, a brave deaf orca, Vincent must face his fears, accept his loss, and discover his own song to save the oceans.

“The Last Whale Singer” is an epic adventure about selfconfidence, the power of collaboration and overcoming grief. Reza Memari is a writer and director, and Co-CEO and co-founder of Telescope Animation.

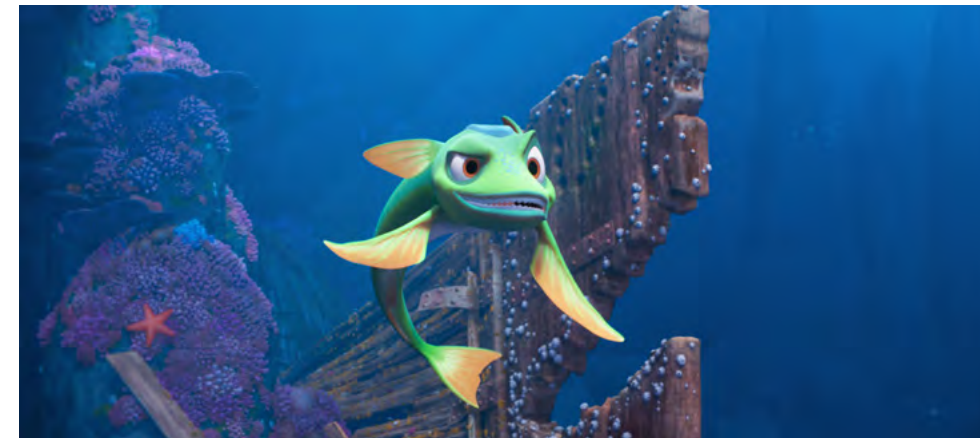

Judith works as an emergency doctor in Berlin. When she inherits a house in Austria from the family who gave her away as a child, her quest to solve the mystery of her origins turns into a nightmarish journey into the past and the dark places of her soul.

Judith has inherited a house she has never heard of, from a family she knew nothing about, who never wanted her and who gave Judith away as a child. She travels to Austria with her husband Ryan to complete the sale of the family home. There she meets her mysterious aunt Paula, who tries to make her stay in the village. The longer Judith stays in her former home, the stronger the images and feelings from her subconscious come to the surface. In her search for the truth, she unleashes forces beyond her imagination, loses control over space and time – and over her own will. She is trapped in her own nightmare. Can Judith break the cycle like her mother tried to do in vain before her?

"Welcome home Baby" is a psychological thriller that uses the tools of the genre to confront us with questions of trauma, identity and self-empowerment. A film that uses atmosphere, associations and ellipses as narrative devices to approach the horror of the incomprehensible.

After years trapped in a stifling life wrangling cattle in the wilds of Canada, Charlotte escapes her controlling husband in a beat-up 1968 Ford Bronco. Her journey leads her back to New York, where she seeks refuge at her childhood home on Park Avenue. There, her estranged mother, Kit, greets her with sharp wit and a blunt question: “Am I dying?”

Over the course of six tumultuous weeks, Charlotte, fiery and irreverent, clashes and connects with Kit, a master of secrets and lies. Together, they navigate old wounds, shared history, and unspoken truths. As Charlotte reconnects with Anders, the building’s doorman and her former love, she is drawn back into the world she left behind at 18. Set against the vibrant backdrop of New York’s Upper East Side and its colorful, intertwined residents, “Park Avenue” delves into the intricate and messy bond between a mother and daughter.

Tells the story of Colonel Birger Eriksen during the most dramatic hours in Norwegian history. It's a suspenseful drama about the biggest decision in the colonel's career. The decision had consequences for the course of the war in Norway, as well as personal consequences for Eriksen after the war.

Set against the backdrop of April 9th, 1940, Colonel Birger Eriksen commands Oscarsborg Fortress, a critical choke point for ships approaching Oslo. Facing severe manpower shortages, a lack of information, and no clear military directives, Eriksen relies on his own judgment as the German forces bear down.

When German warships emerge from the fog, Eriksen orders fire, sinking the Blücher and stalling the invasion. In retaliation, the Luftwaffe bombards Oscarsborg, trapping Eriksen, his polio-afflicted daughter, and the island's residents in a tunnel for ten grueling hours. Eriksen ultimately surrenders the fortress.

The sinking of the Blücher delays the Oslo invasion, allowing the King and government to escape and safeguarding Norway's gold reserves. However, Eriksen's actions are later scrutinized in a military trial, where he must defend his decision to surrender.
